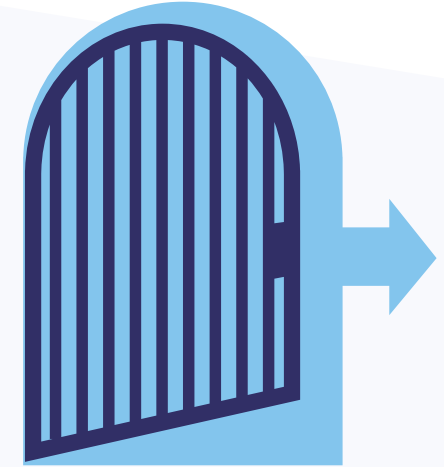

We are seeking volunteers motivated to provide a 'Through The Gate' service to offenders resettling back to West Yorkshire from the following prisons:

- HMP Leeds,
- HMP Wealstun,
- HMP New Hall,
- HMP & YOI Doncaster

Volunteers will be providing:

1. **Face to face mentoring**
2. **Phone support**
3. **Support hubs**

Volunteers will assist an individual to make the best possible start to their resettlement by providing mentoring support to reduce their risk of re-offending and reintegrate into society.



The mentor may support the Service User with any of the following issues:

- Accommodation
- Drugs & Alcohol
- Finance, Debt & Benefits
- Health
- Attitudes, Thinking & Behaviour
- Employment, Training & Education
- Family & Relationships

Groups & Drop-ins

Volunteers will also support the delivery of local drop-in sessions where those using the mentoring service can access further support. These will be provided at an agreed venue between regular set times on a specific day.
