Medieval town of Provins

Protected by impressive ramparts, Provins, the former capital city of the Counts of Champagne, previously known for its trade fairs, is an exceptional medieval site, with many of its monuments dating back to the 12th and 13th centuries.

Château de Fontainebleau

The Fontainebleau Castle, dubbed "house of centuries, true abode of kings", was the favourite residence of the French monarchs, from Francis I to Napoleon III. You cannot help but be captivated by this sumptuous chateau, with its authentic period decoration and furnishings.

This castle, a 17th century masterpiece and the residence of Fouquet, was a source of great jealousy for the King, inspiring him to build the famous Château de Versailles. This castle was produced by three artists: Le Vau, Le Brun and Le Nôtre. When the warm weather arrives, Vaux-le-Vicomte also provides a magical setting for your evening events, with the gardens and Château lit by more than 2,000 candles.
