

AN INVITATION TO AN UPDATE ON THE **CONSTRUCTION PRODUCT REGULATIONS**

July 2013 saw the introduction of **MANDATORY** legislation which dictates what hardware can be legally fitted to Fire Doors and Emergency/Panic Escape Doors.

The Construction Product Regulations make it the responsibility of installers, property owners and buildings managers to install correctly certified hardware onto doors which provide 'life safety'.

All this means is that some of the hardware, which is routinely specified on doors such as Emergency Escapes and Fire Doors, are in effect no longer legal.
